

Make-up and Hair Checklist

As there are so many cast members this year in our production, we are asking all children to come in stage makeup and with their hair done (unless otherwise organise with Ms Swift). Below is the makeup and hair requirements and what should be brought on the night.

1) EVERY ONSTAGE CAST MEMBER NEEDS THE FOLLOWING MAKEUP AND HAIR

- Foundation to suit your own skin tone
- Black mascara (no sharing with other castmates)
- Black eyeliner (no sharing with other castmates)
- Lip balm (no sharing with other castmates)
- (other make-up items are already arranged by the make-up team and will be provided for you)

Banana powder (loose translucent powder) can be applied at the theatre, however, if you have powder and can apply this to your child before they arrive, this will help with time management on show days.

2) CHILDREN WILL NOT APPLY ANY MORE FOUNDATION BUT MAY APPLY MORE POWDER, LIP BALM AND EYELINER. PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING IN YOUR OWN LABELLED ZIP LOCK BAG:

- Black eyeliner (no sharing with other castmates)
- Lip balm (no sharing with other castmates)
- Travel size tissues (to dab sweat/for fixing make-up by artists)
- Travel size pack of cotton bud
- Travel size pack of make-up wipes (in case we need to fix something/if you have character change)
- Hair ties bobby pins (in case we need to fix something/if you have character change)
- Hair brush

3) CAST

- **MAKE-UP REMINDER:** Please don't touch your face once in make-up. Don't hug other people in costume or touch other peoples' faces; you will get make-up on your fingers that will go on costumes or props – big NO NO! Remove your costume CAREFULLY at the end of the show to ensure you don't put make-up on your costume.
- **HAIR:** Please ensure your hair is off your face. Just like our costumes, your hair can be styled in any style (we are going for "eclectic" as possible), as long as it is off your face. Your hair is actually easier to style and look amazing onstage if it is not "super clean"; very clean hair is harder to work with so don't wash your hair the morning of the show
- **VULGARIAN GIRLS:** In the Bombie Samba, you will need hair up in a high pony tail and your head band on. Your parents will not be able to help you with this, but there will be helpers around. However, it would be so much easier if you can put your own hair up. Please practise over the coming week.
- **SEWER GIRLS:** You need messy hair and can have your hair out for Act 2.
